Every year, Lonseal recycles 12.6 million pounds of manufacturing materials via their dedicated product recycling plant, re-investing that material back into the manufacturing process. **Additionally, the company recycles 978,000 gallons of water per day**, and ships our products in **100 percent reusable, 100 percent recyclable packaging**.

Lonseal surfaces provide **greater durability** than most traditional surfaces based on the use of a **UV cured** urethane factory finish that is **more stable, stronger and 3 to 4 times thicker than the industry standard** heat cured urethane. This 100 micron thick protective urethane layer is formulated to provide maximum resistance to foot traffic and most chemicals common to commercial settings. Maintenance of Lonseal surfaces consists of simple and easy cleaning with Loncare neutral pH floor cleaner. This means **fewer harsh chemicals** within a building and, in turn, the environment.

"We take very seriously the impact that the manufacturing process has on the environment," said Lonseal Marketing Director Kinjal Husges. **"That's why Lonseal has made a full commitment to minimizing that impact, from recycling at our facilities to our Sample Re-use Program.** It's important that the products that go into beautiful man-made environments don't take away from the beauty of the natural environment."

As an environmentally conscious design partner, Lonseal provides clients with the most innovative, sustainable, and functional high-performance products on the market. The company's **GreenAir™ Collection** features products that have been reformulated to emit **extremely low levels of VOCs – as much as 90 percent lower levels** than old formulas – ensuring that they adhere to the industry's highest environmental standards. The majority of the firm's products contain **more than 35 percent recycled content, and in some cases more than 50 percent**.
